

**ARC Guest Rower Policy:**

Guest rowers are defined as members in good standing of a rowing club located OUTSIDE of a 50-mile radius of the Austin area. Guests are welcome to attend up to three practices within a 7 day period. Guests who will be rowing more than three times in a 7 day period may be asked to pay a one-month membership fee. Guests who wish to sweep row with a crew may do so as seats are available, and should contact [info@austinrowing.org](mailto:info@austinrowing.org) to make arrangements.

Single scullers must be evaluated and checked out by a coach during regularly scheduled sculling clinics or make arrangements to take a private lesson. The coach will assign the appropriate club single and a member should accompany them on their first outing.

Guest rowers may not sit bow-seat in a double or quad due to the speed and fragility of the boat and their unfamiliarity with the Lady Bird Lake traffic patterns and hazards.

All guests must fill out an ARC waiver and the accompanying information form prior to participating in any rowing activities.
