### Lady Bird Lake Safety Guidelines

- Park hours are 5:00AM to 10:00PM
- All boats (launches, rowing shells, kayaks, rafts, canoes, SUP boards, water bikes, etc) on the water before sunrise or after sunset **must have proper navigation lights** in accordance with the Texas Water Safety Act. This includes a bright white light in the stern and bright red/green lights in the bow designating port and starboard.
- Stay to the right. Head west on the north shore; head east on the south shore.
- Move toward shore when stopping or being passed to allow faster boats the middle lane.
- Avoid traveling down the middle of the lake. Always cross the lake in as straight a line as possible.
- Never stop or turn under or near a bridge. Move a safe distance from bridges before turning or stopping (approx 100 meters).
- Navigate the bridges and the island / dam areas in accordance with the Lady Bird Lake map posted at each facility.
